2025 NATIONAL PESTICIDE USE UPDATES FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

Q What changed on pesticide labels?

A Some labels now direct users to Bulletins Live! Two (BLT), EPA's online map, for printable bulletins with month- and location-specific directions.

Q Do I have to use Bulletins Live! Two (BLT)?

A Only if your label says so. When a label sends you to obtain a bulletin from Bulletins Live! Two (BLT), the bulletin's directions including any Pesticide Use Limitation Areas (PULAs) are enforceable label requirements.

Q Where can I find more information?



A The EPA Mitigation Menu shows which spray-drift and runoff or erosion measures count and the minimum specifications for each measure.

Q What is the Walla Walla Basin PSP?



A The Walla Walla Basin Pesticide Stewardship Partnership (PSP) is voluntary and non-regulatory. Local partners use water-quality monitoring and producer input to guide practical, on-farm fixes that keep pesticides on site while maintaining effective pest control.
